

## Criteria for Jean Hudson Gano Award

Individual nominees should be women of high school age or above whose dedication and excellence in leadership has served her community through her volunteer efforts, either within the preceding year or as a long-term, on-going commitment. Organizations nominated should be those that benefit women and/or children in our community with particular attention being given to the accomplishments within the past year. (Organizations nominated need to supply verification of 501(c)3 status). Nominees from the communities of Berkeley Heights, Chatham, New Providence, and Summit are eligible for the award. The award recipient will be honored at the Junior League of Summit Annual Dinner, and the recipient's name will be displayed on a plaque at the JLS Thrift Shop. Recipients will receive a monetary award of \$500 to use as they see fit, as per the wishes of Jean's father, Mr. William Hudson, who gave the generous gift.
